



Who wants more? A second helping!

We are always fooling around with rules here at Eye-Level Entertainment. A dash of this. A pinch of that. Here are a couple more treats we've cooked up for your gaming pleasure. Delicious!

Variant: "In Medias Res" (a.k.a "Quick Start")

Why start with a clean palate? Let's jump right into the action! At the start of the game, pull one '2 point' and one '3 point' actor from each genre (excluding the crew unless they are being played as a genre too). These characters are the initial actors of the movie.

Players take turns placing (but not moving) those actors onto the sets. Players do not need to 'add the drama!' yet.

After the all the initial actors are placed, players choose their genres and play returns to normal.



Variant: "ROLL Playing"

Some people love to roll dice. This variant uses to determine which actors get picked! Separate and shuffle the rewrite cards. The rest of the casting cards can be put away. You will need two 6-sided dice.

At the start of your turn, you roll the dice instead of drawing a card. One die determines the genre you pick, the other die determines the point value of the actor. However, YOU decide which one is which!



ROLL	GENRE	POINT VALUE
1	Crew	1
2	Detective	2
3	Romance	3
4	Scary	4
5	Western	5
6	Your Choice!	Your Choice!

For example, you roll a 2 and a 5. You could choose to move or place a 5 point Detective piece or a 2 point Western piece.

IF YOU ROLL DOUBLES, pick a rewrite card out of the deck and then roll again. Other than that, play proceeds as normal! (Note, if you need to use the casting cards to break a tie, then have at it!)
